

## ON-VEHICLE INSPECTION

CHECK SIGHT GLASS, FUSIBLE PLUG AND FITTINGS FOR LEAKAGE

Use a gas leak detector. Repair as necessary.



## REMOVAL OF RECEIVER

- 1. RECOVER REFRIGERANT FROM REFRIGERATION SYSTEM
- DISCONNECT TWO LIQUID TUBES FROM RECEIVER
  HINT: Cap the open fittings immediately to keep mois—
  ture out of the system.
- 3. REMOVE RECEIVER FROM RECEIVER HOLDER

## INSTALLATION OF RECEIVER

- INSTALL RECEIVER IN RECEIVER HOLDER
  HINT: Do not remove the blind plugs until ready for
  connection.
- 2. CONNECT TWO LIQUID TUBES TO RECEIVER Torque: 13 N-m (135 kgf-cm, 10 ft-lbf)
- 3. IF RECEIVER WAS REPLACED, ADD COMPRESSOR
  OIL TO COMPRESSOR
  Add 20 cc (0.7 fl.oz.)
  ND OIL 6,
  SUNISO No. 5GS or equivalent.
- 4. EVACUATE AIR FROM AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM
- 5. CHARGE AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM WITH REFRIGERANT AND CHECK FOR GAS LEAKAGE Specified amount: 720 ±50 g (25.4 ±1.8 oz)
